**CAMPING:** Reservations through Reserve America.

**CAMPGROUNDS:** 11 electric and 61 non-electric sites. No permanent water hookups available. Open end of April to end of November.

**CABINS:** 14 cabins. Open May to October.

Comfort Stations: Hot showers and flush toilets

**DAY USE:** A vehicle-use fee to enter park in effect from May to November. Permitted activities are posted in the park office.

Swimming: Stream-fed pool. Only in the lifeguarded area. Swimming available weather and conditions permitting. Call ahead to the park office or log on to [www.earth911.org](http://www.earth911.org), select Water Pollution and Conservation, for availability. Swimming offered from the Saturday of Fourth July weekend to Labor Day.

## Special Passes

The **Access Pass** is available to New Yorkers with qualifying disabilities. The **Golden Park Program** allows New York State residents 62 years of age or older unlimited weekday and non-holiday access to all state parks by showing a NYS driver's license or non-driver identification. The **Empire Passport** provides unlimited vehicle entry to most state parks and recreation areas. Passes can be purchased in person at most state parks or recreation areas, or by mail from State Parks, Albany, NY 12238.
